4 Steps to a Safe Donation!

1

Wear protective equipment

Wear a mask when you are around anything you may donate.

Homemade masks are acceptable.



2

Wash your hands

Wash your hands thoroughly before touching anything you may donate.

Be mindful to not touch your face.

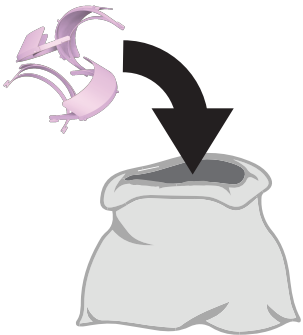


3

Collect your items

Stick all items to be donated in a plastic bag.

Close the plastic bag between fillings.

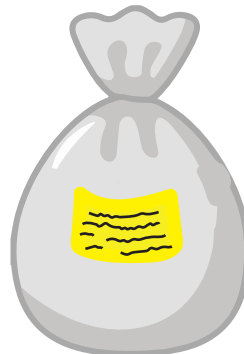


4

Provide information

Seal the bag and label with the following info:

- Date/Time of Sealing
- What items you are donating
- Quantity of items donated



Safely Receive Donations

With sanitizing equipment in short supply, spraying donations with alcohol or bleach is not scale-able.

If you are receiving donations, we recommend, if time allows, not opening them until 3 days after they were sealed to limit the spread of COVID-19 in your facility.
